

Practical Information for STUDENTS

Intensive Programme "Food and Health" Paris 22 August-2 September 2005

Dormitories

There will be 2 dormitories for the students.

Both the dormitories are part of the Cité Universitaire de Paris.

- There are 20 double rooms : la **Maison de l'INA P-G**
 - From Sunday 21 August (morning) till Sunday 4 September (morning)
 - The students go directly to la maison de l'INA P-G and ask for the key of their room at the reception.
 - Opening hours of the reception : Sunday from 18.00 – 22.00 and Monday from 9.00 – 22.00
 - Address : Maison de l'INA 7B, Boulevard Jourdan 75014 Paris.

- There are 10 single rooms at la **Maison des Arts et Métiers**.
 - From Monday 22 August (morning) till Saturday 3 September (morning)
 - Address : Maison des Arts et Métiers - 1, avenue Pierre Masse - 75014 PARIS,

 - The students staying in this dormitory can only get access to their rooms on Monday 22 August. The keys of the rooms will be given during the welcome reception on Monday evening. Therefore those students go **DIRECTLY** to INA PG, 16 rue Claude Bernard – 75231 Paris cedex 05

The showers are in the hall and not separate per room.

Bed sheets are available. Towels or washing gloves on the other hand are to be brought by the students themselves.

How to reach your different destinations?

La Cité Universitaire de Paris :

Both dormitories are situated in the Cité Universitaire Internationale de Paris.

Important on this map are:

- n°5 : Maison de l'INA PG
- n°22 : Maison internationale : This is where the cafeteria and the terrace are and where you can have your breakfast.
- N°26 : Maison des Arts et Métiers.

How to reach la Cité Universitaire de Paris ?

- By public transport :
 - The 'cité universitaire' can be reached by metro : RER B, stop Cité universitaire, by bus PC, station Cité universitaire, by bus 21, station Cité universitaire.
 - **From Orly Airport** (less than 15 minutes).
Take the « l'Orlyval » till the station Anthony.
At Anthony, take the metro RER B direction centre of Paris (direction Airport Charles de Gaulle / Mitry – Claye)
Get off at the station Cité Universitaire
 - **From Roissy-Charles de Gaulle Airport** (45 minutes direct by the metro RER B)
Take the metro RER B direction Robinson / ST Rémy les chevreuses till the station Cité Universitaire.
 - **From la gare du Nord** (30 minutes direct by metro RER B)
Take the metro RER B direction Robinson / ST Rémy les chevreuses till the station Cité Universitaire.
- By car : Take the Périphérique Sud, junction Porte d'Orléans or Porte de Gentilly.
The entrance for cars is situated at 27 bd Jourdan.
There will be a free car park available at INA PG, 16 rue Claude Bernard, 75231 Paris Cedex 05. **THIS HAS TO BE BOOKED AT THE BEGINNING OF JULY !!!**

Meals

At the cafeteria of the Cité Universitaire you can have **breakfast** for 3,5 euro per person.

Location cafeteria: see map Cité U.

In order to avoid waiting we advise lunch to take place at 13.15 o'clock.

Diners : free to choose by the students

Internet access

Normally the computer rooms will be available for the students.
The local organisers will ask for access for you.
More details will be given the first days of your stay in Paris.

!! IMPORTANT REMARKS !!

1) Metro/bus ticket

You will need tickets for the **metro** to go from your dormitory to the faculty.
We advise you to buy 2 tickets of a week (1 ticket for the first week and a second for the second week) as this is a lot cheaper. The price per week is 15 euro. In this price transportation by bus is also included.

You will, however, need a **passport PHOTO**.

You had better buy the ticket for the first week upon arrival in Paris. Please note that the tickets are only valuable from Monday, so if you arrive on Saturday or Sunday you will have to buy a single ticket extra.

2) Late arrival

May we ask the students to advise us in advance if they will arrive after the opening hours of the reception of the dormitories.

3) Students coming by car

If there are students who are coming by car, please advise us in advance, so we can book a car park for you at the faculty.
